## About The Conductor

**Douglas R. McEwen** holds a bachelor's degree from Bowling Green State University, a master's degree from Indiana University and a doctorate from the University of Northern Colorado. Dr. McEwen's background is rich in the areas of both teaching and performance. He began his teaching and conducting career in California; first in the public schools and for four years at LaVerene College. Moving to Colorado, he was Director of Choral Activities at the University of Northern Colorado for three years, followed by six years in the same capacity at the University of New Mexico, Albuquerque.

For twenty years as Director of Choirs at Arizona State University, Tempe, Dr. McEwen guided students through choral experiences from the undergraduate through the doctoral levels. Recently retired, he was appointed Professor Emeritus of Music on the ASU faculty.

In wide demand as conductor and choral clinician, Dr. McEwen has in recent years conducted more than fifty all-state choirs and many more festival choruses from coast to coast. He has served as assistant director of the Meadowbrook Choral Institute and has appeared as guest conductor with the Minnesota Symphony and the Phoenix Symphony. As assistant conductor and soloist, he toured the Middle East and Europe with the Roger Wagner Chorale. For two years he served as Director of Choral Masterworks for the International Youth and Music Festival in Vienna, Austria. He is a past president of the Western Division of the American Choral Directors Association.
