PAUL SALAMUNOVICH - Director

William Hickman, Connie Bilyeu - Accompanists

Paul Salamunovich is a Professor of Music at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles where he has been a member of the faculty since 1964. In addition, he is also Director of Music at St. Charles Borromeo Church in North Hollywood (38 years) and St. Basil's Church in Los Angeles (17 years). His contributions to Church music have been recognized by the Vatican with a Knighthood in the Order of St. Gregory.

Acknowledged foremost as an authority in the teaching and conducting of Gregorian Chant and music of the Renaissance, Salamunovich's diverse choral background has included all phases of the choral art from singing in Boys' Choirs to conducting in famous concert halls and singing, arranging and conducting choral segments of major motion pictures for such studios as Warner Bros., Columbia and Universal.

His long association with Roger Wagner included a Charter Membership in the Roger Wagner Chorale, a 24-year period ending in 1977 as Associate Conductor of the Wagner and Los Angeles Master Chorales, and two appearances as guest conductor of the Los Angeles Master Chorale at the Los Angeles Music Center in 1975 and 1986.

The St. Charles and St. Basil Choirs, under Salamunovich's direction, have sung for television and motion pictures, performed at the Ecumenical Services for the Biennial National Convention of the American Choral Directors' Association in New Orleans in 1981 and, in 1985, conducted a three-week tour of Europe culminating in a private audience with Pope John Paul II in the Clementine Hall of the Vatican Palace.

The Loyola Marymount University Choruses presented the concluding concert of the 1982 Western Division American Choral Directors' Association Convention in Pasadena, California and in March of 1987 the LMU Men's Chorus will perform at the Biennial National Convention of the A.C.D.A. in San Antonio, Texas.

Paul Salamunovich has conducted close to 600 choral festivals, clinics and summer music camps throughout the United States, Canada and Europe, including 46 all-States and 3 Regional Music Educators' National Convention Choirs.
