Howard Swan, director of the 1980 Missouri All State Choir is one of the most sought-after and one of the most highly-respected choral directors in the United States.

Dr. Swan was professor of music at Occidental College from 1934 until 1971. He then taught on the staff of California State University at Fullerton until his retirement in 1977. He has studied music with John F. Williamson, founder of the Westminster Choir College and with Father William J. Finn, famed boy choir director and music educator. He has also worked closely with colleagues Robert Shaw, Julius Herford and Paul Salamunovich, among others.

He has conducted clinics and workshops at over forty colleges and universities and has directed thirteen honor or all state choirs throughout the nation.

Dr. Swan is a member of MENC and is an Honorary Life Member of ACDA. His integrity, enthusiasm, and joy of good choral music have inspired choral directors throughout the United States.

In addition to directing the All State Choir he will lead three sessions for Missouri Music Educators. Missouri is truly fortunate to have Dr. Swan as a clinician at the MMEA Convention and as director of the 1980 Missouri All State Choir.
